PROMOTION POLICY
 Grades 9, 10, 11, 12
 22 CREDITS NEEDED TO GRADUATE

To be promoted to Grade 10:
The following 5 Credits must be completed:

- 1 English
- 2 Math, Science, or Social Studies
- 2 Additional credits

To be promoted to Grade 11:
The following 10 Credits must be completed:

- 2 English
- 4 Math, Science, or Social Studies
- 4 Additional credits

To be promoted to Grade 12:
15 Credits must be completed:

Student must be enrolled in all courses needed for graduation – Senior schedule must include English 12 and a Math class.

PROMOTION POLICY
 Grades 9, 10, 11, 12
 24 CREDITS NEEDED TO GRADUATE

To be promoted to Grade 10:
The following 5 Credits must be completed:

- 1 English
- 1 Math
- 1 Science, Social Studies, or World Language
- 2 Additional credits

To be promoted to Grade 11:
The following 11 Credits must be completed:

- 2 English
- 2 Math
- 2 Science, Social Studies, or World Language
- 5 Additional credits

To be promoted to Grade 12:
The following 17 Credits must be completed:

- 3 English
- 3 Math
- 3 Science or Social Studies
- 1 World Language
- 7 Additional credits

Student must be enrolled in all courses needed for graduation. Senior schedule must include English 12 and a Math class.

Social Studies	3 credits (must include U.S. History)
Mathematics	4 credits (must include math in the sr. yr.)
Science	3 credits (must include Biology)
Health	½ credit

World Language	2 credits
Career Pathway	3 Credits (AFC, CTE, IFC)
Elective Credits	3 ½
Total Credits needed to graduate = 24	

PROMOTION POLICY
 Grades 9, 10, 11, 12
 24 CREDITS NEEDED TO GRADUATE

To be promoted to Grade 10:
The following 6 Credits must be completed:

- 1 English
- 1 Math
- 2 Science, Social Studies, or World Language
- 2 Additional credits

To be promoted to Grade 11:
The following 12 Credits must be completed:

- 2 English
- 2 Math
- 2 Science, Social Studies, or World Language
- 5 Additional credits

To be promoted to Grade 12:
The following 17 Credits must be completed:

- 3 English
- 3 Math
- 4 Science or Social Studies
- 1 World Language
- 6 Additional credits

Student must be enrolled in all courses needed for graduation. Senior schedule must include English 12 and a Math class which must be at the Alg. II, Int. Math III or higher.
