ESL Class Recommended Summer Work

1. READ Books, Magazines, comic books, websites, etc.
2. Work on READ WORKS. I will be checking each week to grade assignments and add more stories.
Go to readworks.org
Sign in with your Google Account
6th grade class code: 7QLJZS (for incoming 6th graders)
7th graders class code: UDEVAL
8th grade class code: TB3PJE
Choose the story you would like to read. Most will have the option to listen to the audio.
Some stories include vocabulary. Some stories have different StepReads. These are different versions of the story and are easier to read.
After working through the vocabulary and the story. Answer the comprehension questions and submit them.
3. Discuss things – if you visit a location or your relatives, talk about the visit with you family. If you hear about things on the news, discuss those topics with your parents.
4. WRITE! Write texts, emails, and letters. Write about what you read. Write good sentences on READ WORKS.
5. Practice your math facts! Memorize addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division facts. Look for practical math experiences every day. If you order a pizza, what fraction of the pizza did you eat?
