

2020-2021 Lancashire Second Grade Supply List & Remote Learning Preparation

Dear Families,

We are looking forward to the 2020-2021 school year and launching this new adventure! We've put together some thoughts about how you can prepare at home as we start our year with remote learning. Children will be receiving a Chromebook and other materials from the District. There are also some supplies you may need to get. So, it's time to think about where to do this learning and how to keep materials organized.

To begin, we think it's best if students have a consistent and distraction free space dedicated to their school work. Sitting at a table or desk is ideal. If your child is working in a multiuse space (like the kitchen table) he or she should have some sort of box, basket, or bag that all learning materials can be kept in and moved easily. A container about the size of a milk crate or good size book bag would probably be perfect. Smaller items such as pencils, erasers, pencil sharpeners, etc. should be kept in some sort of smaller box or bag so they are easy for children to find when they need them. **Whether your child has a dedicated desk or table just for learning or is in a multi-use space, learning materials should be within reach during class and kept organized.**

In addition to his or her school books and Chromebook these are the materials your child should have within reach each day. You may need to purchase some of them:

- Loose leaf paper
- Two 2 pocket folder
- Scissors
- Sharpened pencils with erasers
- Pencil sharpener to keep pencils sharpened (a small inexpensive handheld is all you need)
- 2 Black dry erase markers and some sort of eraser (a tissue would even work)
- 1 box of 24 crayons or colored pencils (if colored pencils a sharpener should be needed)
- Container(s) to keep learning materials and supplies organized
- *Optional: earbuds or headphones to use with the Chromebook

We believe that most of these materials should be available at a Dollar Store.

We hope you can have fun working with your child to come up with a consistent organization plan that will help get the year started on the right foot and thank you for your help preparing your child for the start of the school year!
