



Kindergarten Supply List 2020-2021

- **1 Backpack (no wheels, large enough to fit a folder)**
 - 2 packs of crayons
 - 2 packs of markers
 - 2 packs of glue sticks
 - 2 boxes of tissues
 - 1 roll of paper towels
 - 1 pack of pencils
 - 1 pack of dry erase markers
 - 1 container of disinfectant wipes
 - 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
 - 1 box of sandwich or gallon size Ziploc bags

First Grade General Ed. School Supply List:
