ZOOMERS AND ROOMERS

The fourth grade is ready to start the 4th marking period. We have a few reminders to keep your student engaged and making progress.

All students should be completing at least 4 Zearn Math Digital lessons per week.

We have added Geometry and other units to Dreambox for your student to work on.

We will continue our work on fractions. Students will be decomposing, comparing, ordering, adding, subtracting and multiplying fractions. After fractions, we will begin our unit on Decimals. Students will learn to add and subtract decimals. This is tough stuff, but if students are engaged, focused, and completing ZEARN digital lessons to aid in their understanding, they will succeed.

We will finish up our Science instruction on "Magnetism and Electricity". Then we will begin working on a Social Studies for Marking Period 4. We will be covering U.S. History up through the Revolutionary War and Economics.

Ways to help your child succeed while learning virtually

- Please attempt to provide a quiet space where your child can focus.
- Is there a table or a desk your child can utilize rather than lying in bed?
- Headphones are recommended to help hear better and limit distractions.
- Eat all food outside of classroom instruction times.
- Have all supplies ready and organized.
- Review EPIC Books or Zearn/Dreambox materials with your child at night.
