## Remote Learning

### 1ST MARKING PERIOD GRADING

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#### ELEMENTARY

- Work completion and quality of work submitted will be factored into the student's grade for the marking period.
- Students are required to complete asynchronous learning activities for social-emotional learning and specials. There is flexibility with the timing for completion of these assignments as they are due the following Monday at 8:00am.
- Other asynchronous learning activities will be due based on the teacher's direction and could be required for a specific day's lesson.
- Teachers will conduct various assessments in each content area at least once per week. Examples of these assessments include exit tickets, self-reflections, and written responses. Assessments will be used to inform future instruction and to track a student's learning journey.
- Grades are one of many indicators of your child's learning progression and will communicate where a student is in their learning journey. Students will be graded on their ability to demonstrate proficiency with grade level skills and concepts, aligned with the State Standards. This will be reported on their report card.

#### MIDDLE & HIGH

- Work completion and quality of work submitted will be factored into the student's grade for the marking period.
- Students will engage in asynchronous learning activities on Wednesday.
  - Students will be required to submit a work product for each of their classes (e.g., exit ticket, discussion board, work submission, etc.).
  - Students will have until 11:59 pm on Wednesday to submit their asynchronous work assignments.
- Students will have at least 4 formative assessments and 2 summative assessments for the first marking period in each of their classes.
- Grades will reflect your student's progress towards mastery of the course content standards.
- Final Grade Determination
  - The 1st marking period is shorter than the remaining marking periods in the school year. As a result the weight of each marking period is as follows:
    - Marking Period 1: 20%
    - Marking Period 2: 25%
    - Marking Period 3: 25%
    - Marking Period 4: 25%
    - Final Exam: 5%
  - Please keep in mind that this is a fluid situation and we may adjust calculations based on new information.
