



HYBRID LEARNING FAQS

WILL MY CHILD KEEP THE SAME TEACHER?

The goal for both in-person and remote learners is for students to keep their current teacher(s). However, this is subject to change based on several factors, including the availability of the teacher to deliver in-person instruction. Parents will be notified if their student will be impacted by a change in teacher.

WHAT WILL THE CLASSROOM EXPERIENCE LOOK LIKE? WILL STUDENTS BE SITTING AT THEIR DESKS WHILE ZOOMING?

Students in the classroom will be engaged in activities that may or may not require their chromebooks. They will be part of the in-person Zoom from the teacher's camera or computer.

HOW WILL THE TEACHER INTERACT WITH THE STUDENTS IN THE CLASSROOM AND THE STUDENTS LEARNING REMOTELY?

All students, whether at home or in the classroom, will receive synchronous instruction from the classroom teacher on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays. While the students in class are working independently, the teacher will have an opportunity provide support to those students learning remotely and vice versa.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN ON WEDNESDAYS?

Starting November 11, Wednesdays will be asynchronous for all grade levels. Aside from individually scheduled sessions or therapies, Wednesdays will begin with an opportunity for students who chose remote learning to receive additional synchronous support from their teacher(s) from 8:35-9:35. The remainder of the day will be for asynchronous (independent) learning lessons for related arts and social emotional learning. Students have some flexibility with completion of the Wednesday asynchronous assignments as they will be due the following Monday at 8 am.

ARE STUDENTS LOSING INSTRUCTIONAL TIME WITH THE SHORTENED SCHOOL DAY?

The blocks of instructional time for each academic area will remain the same as they were at the start of the school year.

DO STUDENTS NEED TO BRING THEIR CHROMEBOOKS AND SUPPLIES WITH THEM EVERY DAY?

Yes. Students should bring their chromebooks with them on the days they are in school.

WILL THERE BE LOANER CHROMEBOOKS IF A STUDENT FORGETS THEIRS? WHAT ABOUT CHARGERS?

It is imperative that students charge their chromebooks each night and bring them to school with them every day they are in school. The school will have a small supply of chromebooks for emergencies, but these will be available on a very limited basis.
