



## Guidelines for Brandywine School District 2022-2023 School Year

Brandywine School District will follow all CDC guidelines in conjunction with Delaware Department of Education and Delaware Department of Public Health guidance.



Families should report positive cases to the COVID Reporting Line (302-793-5095). You will receive a return phone call with further information for your student. As a reminder, this school year families do NOT need to report exposures. BSD staff members will continue to utilize the reporting form in Classlink.



If your student tests positive – they must isolate at home for five (5) days. After five days, they can return to school (with guidance from the COVID Reporting Line) but must wear a well-fitting mask through Day 10.



Masks will remain optional for all students and staff members, except for those students and staff returning after isolation. Well-fitting masks remain a great tool to protect yourself and others and to help prevent the spread of COVID-19 and other respiratory illnesses.



Hand washing will remain an important tool for stopping the spread of germs or illness, including COVID-19. We will continue to encourage hand washing and hand sanitizing.



Our buildings continue to have optimized ventilation in addition to routine cleaning, sanitizing, and disinfection with EPA-approved products.
