Dear Parents:

Springer Middle School, in partnership with the University of Delaware's Center for Economic Education and Entrepreneurship, Delaware Financial Literacy Institute, the State Bank Commissioner will be reopening the Bank at School program. Springer Middle School's banking partner is New Castle County School Employees Federal Credit Union.

Based on State Economic Standards, the **Bank at School** program is designed to teach students about economics and financial management through hands-on experience. Starting on **September 14, 2016**, bankers from NCCSEFCU will make weekly visits to the school to accept student deposits and help students learn about the world of banking. This real-life banking experience will help students practice the life skills to become wise consumers and prudent savers.

- ✓ Students have an opportunity to open non-custodial (student's name only) interest-bearing **savings accounts**.
- ✓ Students in grades 6-8 will be able to open accounts.
- ✓ An account can be opened with a minimum \$1.00 deposit and a completed parent permission form.
- ✓ NCCSEFCU charges no fees and there are no minimum-balance requirements.
- ✓ Only **deposits** may be made at school.
- ✓ Your child will receive an ID card with their photo to use with Shared Branching. You can choose to opt out of the photo ID card.
- ✓ NCCSEFCU is a member of Shared Branching, so business (including withdrawals) may be conducted at any credit union that participates in the Shared Branching network (this includes most credit unions in our area) with a photo ID.
- ✓ The bank will be open for business every **Wednesday** from 11:15-1:25PM (lunch period).

In order for your child to participate, please complete the attached form and return it to school. This program is a unique opportunity for Springer Middle School students. We encourage all students to participate, but participation is strictly voluntary. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me at (302) 479-1621.

How to Open a Bank At School Account

The Springer Middle School Branch of New Castle County School Employees Federal Credit Union (NCCSEFCU) will open its **Bank at School** on Wednesday, September 14, 2016

Be \$mart and \$ave!

- Students in grades 6-8 will have the opportunity to open **non-custodial savings accounts**. The account is set up in the child's name alone; parents will not be able to withdraw these funds.
- Accounts are provided to Bank at School participants free of charge.
- NCCSEFCU at Springer Middle School will operate every **Wednesday** from 11:15AM to 1:25PM during lunch.
- School branch banks are for **deposits only**.
- Withdrawals may be made at any participating Shared Branching Credit Union.
- Attached is the **Account Opening Permission Form**; please return this form in an envelope with your child's name printed on it. **We must have your child's entire social security number or ITIN number to open the account.**
- A child's account will be opened upon receipt of the completed permission slip and a minimum \$1.00 deposit.
- After the initial deposit, there are no restrictions as to how much or how often a child must deposit. Any amount is acceptable.
