SCHOOL HOURS

Please keep in mind the school hours. **Arrival:** The doors open at 8:35 am. No students should be dropped off earlier than 8:35 am (unless they are signed up at the YMCA before care), as there is no staff available to supervise the students. Students are late after 8:50am. **Dismissal:** The front doors open at 3:15pm. Dismissal begins at 3:25 pm. After signing your student out, please exit out the back door, not the front, in order to keep the flow of traffic moving. There are no dismissals in the office after 3:00 pm. Thank you for your assistance.

PARKING LOT/ DROP OFF AND DISMISSAL

Parents: Please be very mindful while driving through the parking lot during morning arrival and afternoon dismissal. Please drive slowly and with caution at all times, exercising extreme caution when backing out or pulling out of a parking space. Here are a few specific reminders:

- Please do not park in the handicapped spaces unless you have a displayed handicapped placard.
- Please do not park on the grass area nearest to the circle as it slows down our bus traffic.
- Miss Campbell, one of our paraprofessionals, is on duty in the parking lot in the morning, and can assist you if need be.
- Please do not pull into the circle before 8:30 for drop off or before 3:45 for pick up. This causes difficulties with the movement of the bus traffic. When pulling into the circle, please drive slowly and carefully, as students might still be moving on the sidewalk as they are entering the building.
- Lombardy staff is on duty from 8:35-8:50 and then again at 3:25-3:40.



Reminder!

- When walking your student out from P.M. Car Riders, please keep them with you, and not allow running in the parking lot. (Both the back and front lots.)

Thank you for your attention to these reminders. The safety of our students is always our top priority and we very much appreciate your cooperation.

OUTSIDE RECESS

Please be advised that students do go outside for recess, weather permitting. The National Nurses' Association has established the following guidelines for outdoor recess during the winter months. **Feels like 25 degrees and above, outdoor recess. Feels like 24 degrees or below, inside recess.** Please be sure students are dressed appropriately. This means winter coats, gloves, hats, scarves, etc. All students must go outside for recess unless a doctor's note is presented stating the medical reason the student needs to stay inside.
